

Graphite - Stripe Payments Onboarding Guide

Graphite is transitioning to an in-platform integration with Stripe to power payouts to all Experts for project invoices.

As an Expert hired for 1 or more contractor projects on Graphite **you will be automatically prompted to complete your Stripe onboarding** on logging in or accessing the work management tools of your projects so that we can remit funds to you.

Onboarding for payouts consists of a simple, guided process on Graphite to securely enter your identity & banking information - **this can take as little as 2-3 minutes!**

See below for a quick walkthrough - note that as you complete each step, all of your information is saved automatically and you can resume when ready!

Step 1 - Basic Information

<u>On logging in to Graphite</u> or navigating to the Work management tools on any Active project you've been hired for, you'll be automatically prompted to begin:



To start, indicate how you wish to receive payment - as an **Individual** or a **Company**. Simply enter your information, ensuring it is accurate, and proceed.

Step 2 - Initial Stripe Setup

On submitting your entity info & address, you'll be taken to a Graphite - Stripe experience to complete onboarding.

First, verify your phone number for 2 factor authentication on Stripe:



Next, you'll be prompted for important taxpayer identification information (including date of birth and your taxpayer ID #). Stripe requires this info for 1099 purposes and to confirm the identity of those receiving funds.



Step 3 - Business Details

Next, Stripe will ask for the URL of your business (eg, if applicable, your consulting firm website).

NOTE: Given that many Experts are paid as Individuals, and some businesses do not have URLs, a URL is NOT required. **If you do not have a business website, click the "No URL" link in the info section** and you'll be asked to instead briefly describe your services.

Stripe requires this URL or services description for KYC purposes - this helps them verify that they are not processing payouts to fraudulent businesses.

With either a business website URL or your services description, click Continue to go to the next step.

If entering services ("product") description, please note that this can be relatively brief, and can mention the type of consulting services you provide and how invoicing runs via Graphite on a recurring or milestone basis.



Step 4 - Banking Details

Stripe will now ask for your bank details so that they can send funds to you.

Link your account either via selecting your banking provider and entering your online credentials OR entering your bank account details manually, if preferred:
